Advising Jamie Keith on faculty interviews for research compliance initiative

The council discussed the research compliance initiative objectives statement. They would like approximately 30 names. Focus groups will also be conducted with Safety Compliance officers and Associate Deans for Research.

Report on indirect costs returns

University Intellectual Property Advisory Committee proposal from Student Senate

Ashley Wills, a student Senator, proposed a resolution for the development of a committee for intellectual property. This committee would consist of faculty, staff and students to discuss intellectual property policies. Tom Walsh suggested that the students talk to the Association of University Technology Managers. The council suggested that it may be appropriate for the Student Senate to form an ad hoc committee to produce a report on the subject and take the report to the General Counsel, Division of Sponsored Research and technology licensing. Ms. Willis will invite Dr. Wingo and Walsh to a student senate meeting to discuss this issue further.
