### Tenure and Promotion survey

Dr. Pauly updated the council on the faculty club. Dr. Pauly met with the Harn Museum of Art and discussed holding a faculty club on Thursday nights in the spring. Chris Snodgrass noted that the Faculty Club should be a regular event.

## Career Flexibility Policies and Search Committee Toolkit Report

Dr. King reported that the modules are currently online for everyone. Currently only the chairs need to be certified however, by the time interviews start everyone will need to be certified. The certification is valid for three years.

# UF Faculty Climate Survey 2007

The council will focus on areas of relevance to the council's mission and identify ways to make a difference in these areas.

The council will also work to determine if negative scores are related to lack of knowledge about programs or because programs are not meeting the needs of faculty members. The council will start by looking at career development and quality of life.
