Article III THE FACULTY

Section 1. FACULTY DEFINED. The faculty of the University of Florida are those persons employed appointed full-time by the University of Florida during the regular academic year whose primary assignment is to carry out the academic mission of the University, namely, teaching, research and academic service. Titles of these persons shall be set forth in the Senate Bylaws, except that a person with one of the listed titles whose primary assignment is in a support capacity (for example, financial officer or supervisor of computer services) shall not be considered a member of the faculty. Questions about the faculty status of an individual shall be resolved by a committee charged with evaluating academic qualifications in the college in which the individual is appointed. The committee shall determine status based on whether the primary assignment is the carrying out of the academic mission of the University.
