



RE: Request to sunset MCE and ENG degree programs in CCE

In our departmental faculty meeting on February 28, 2006, our faculty voted to sunset the programs of the Master of Civil Engineering degree in Civil Engineering, Engineer degree in Civil Engineering, and Engineer degree in Coastal and Oceanographic Engineering. The reason for this action is that these three degree programs have had very few students in the last five years. The elimination of these programs will help to make the operation of the graduate programs in the Department of Civil and Coastal Engineering more efficient.

The department does not have any students currently that are pursuing any of these degrees. Also, the department just graduated the last student who was pursuing the Master of Civil Engineering degree.
