Graduate School of Business

The Warrington College of Business has been gifted by a generous donor (\$30 million) who is especially interested in graduate education. The negotiations that preceded the signing of the gift agreement resulted in the following recognition statement, "The University shall name the graduate school of business, 'The Hough Graduate School of Business' ". This naming opportunity was approved by the President and the Foundation before we approached the donor. Subsequently, the gift agreement was signed by all of the appropriate parties, including President Machen, and a public announcement of the largest gift in UF history was made January 19<sup>th</sup>. Apparently all concerned were not aware that the necessary processes for establishing this organizational unit had not been completed and the College would like to repair this procedural matter as soon as possible.

The College seeks approval to establish a Graduate School of Business. This entity provides a naming opportunity for a donor with an interest in graduate education and a commitment to support the College and the University. This is a request for a naming entity only. The College has no interest or ability to take on the functions of the Graduate School of the University. The degrees, transcripts and diplomas of the graduate programs of the College will still be issued and imprinted by the Graduate School of the University. We seek and expect no change in functionality only an opportunity for a donor to indicate by his gift and name serious and continuing interest in graduate education.
