

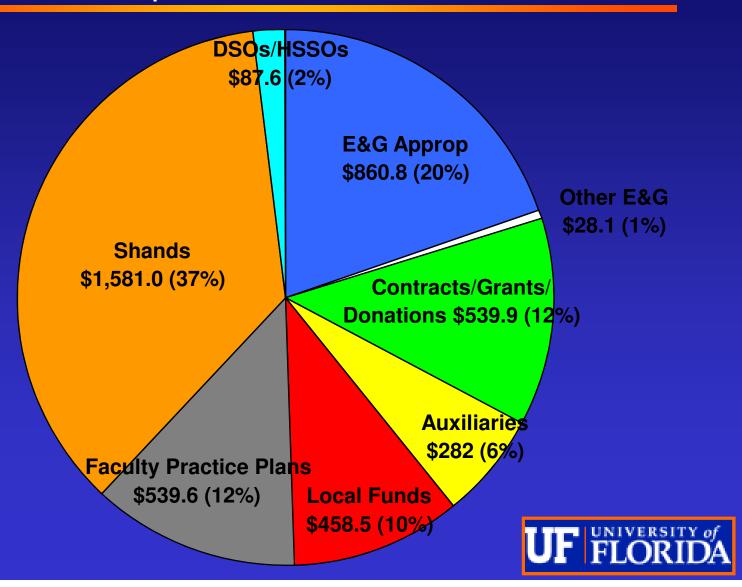

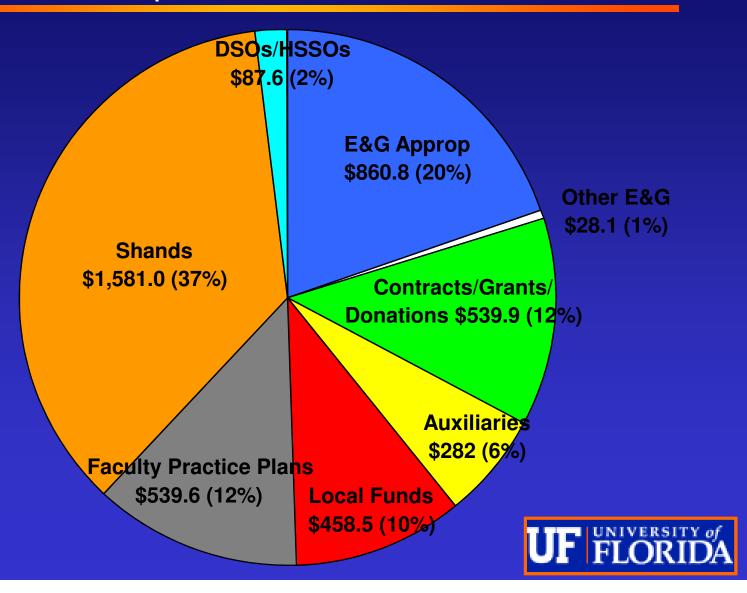




#### DSOs/HSSOs Operating Budgets: \$87.6 Million

- Affiliated organizations, including:
  - UF Foundation (\$23.2 million)
  - UF Research Foundation (\$23.3 million)
  - 4-H IFAS: \$1.3 million
  - Others UF Alumni Association; Law Center Assoc.
- Does not include UAA, which is included in the Local Funds category

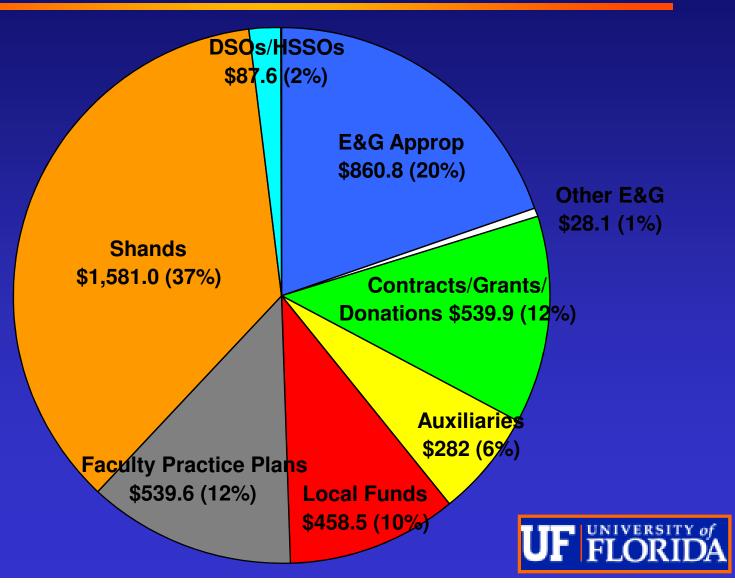




### **Shands: \$1.581 Billion Faculty Practice Plans: \$539.6 Million**

- Faculty Practice Plans includes all plans from:
  - College of Medicine (GNV): \$289.7 million
  - College of Medicine (JAX): \$208.0 million
  - College of Dentistry: \$12.9 million
  - PHHP: \$3.3 million
  - College of Nursing: \$0.913 million
  - College of Veterinary Medicine: \$0.586 million
  - College of Pharmacy \$98,500
  - Other contributions for positions, etc.:\$24 million

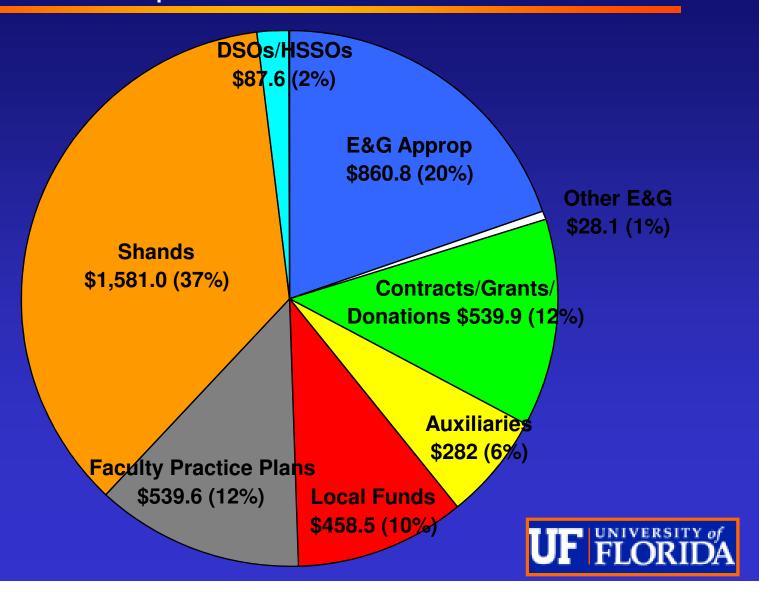




#### Local Funds: \$458.5 Million

- Student financial aid: \$336 million
- Student activities: \$16.3 million
- Concession: \$0.815 million
- Self-insurance program: \$30.1 million
- UAA: \$75.2 million

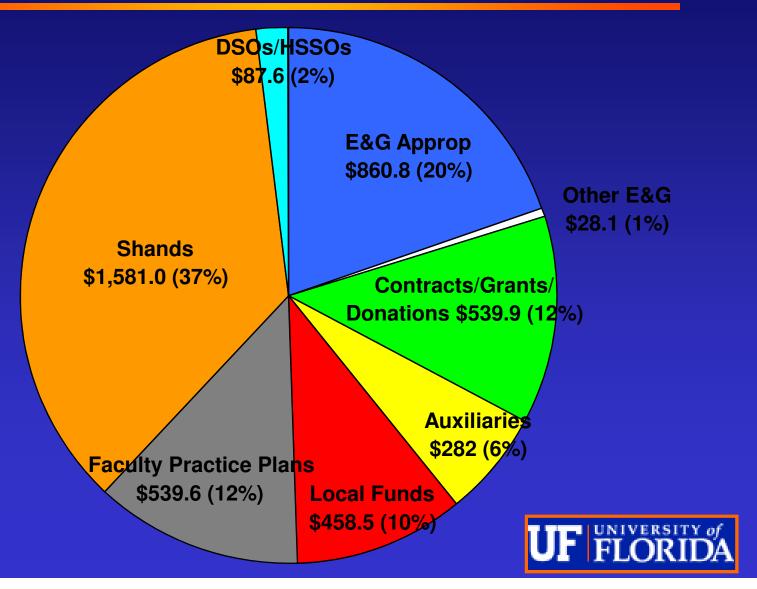




#### **Auxiliaries: \$282 Million**

- Examples of Auxiliary Units:
  - Div of Continuing Education: \$45.3 million
  - Housing: \$39.1 million
  - Student Health Services: \$15.2 million
  - Transportation & Parking Svcs: \$16.3 million
  - Telecommunications: \$5.5 million



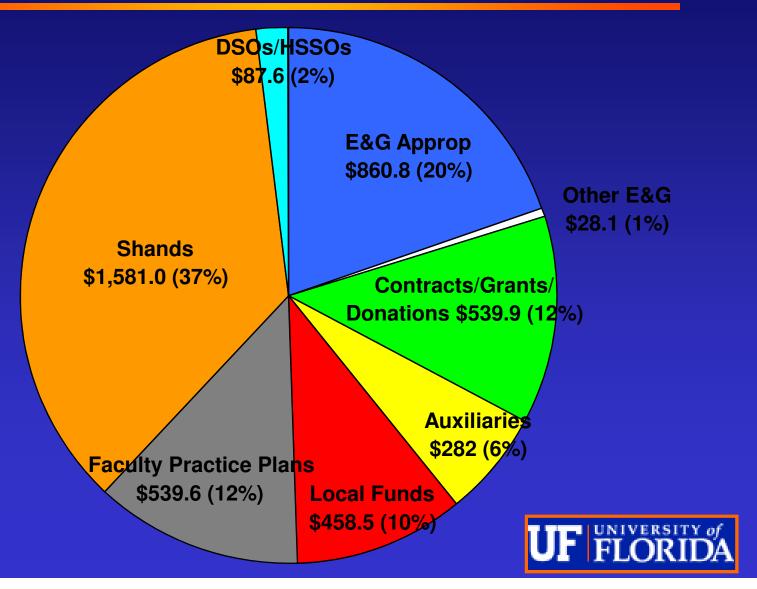


#### Contracts/Grants/Donations Expenses: \$539.9 Million

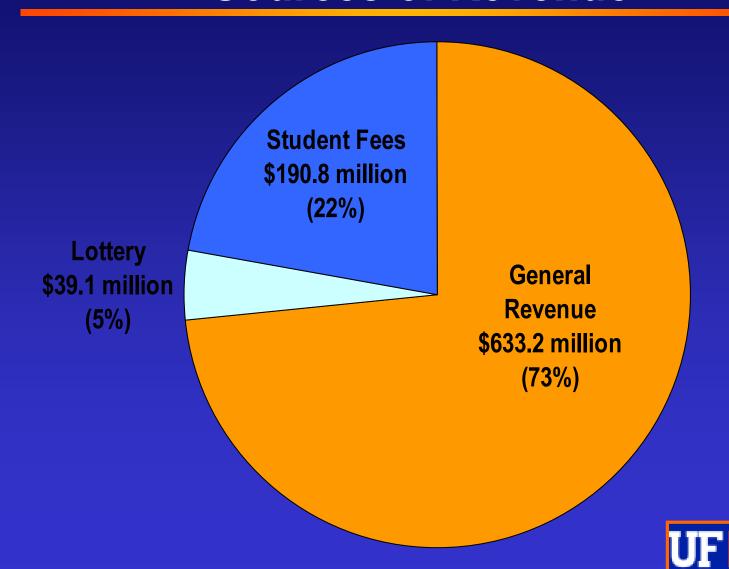
#### **Revenue Estimates**

- Federal grants: \$312 million
- State grants: \$66.2 million
- Private & other grants: \$66.2 million
- Donations from component units: \$107.8 million
- Investment earnings: \$12.6 million

#### **UF's Current Efforts to Meet Reductions and Unfunded Commitments**

- Hiring freeze
  - > Result: reduction in faculty
  - > Result: reduction in staff
- Reduced/postponed equipment acquisition
- Reduced/postponed maintenance
- Reduced/postponed professional development

- Established Cost Containment and Efficiency Task Force
- Engaged Huron Consulting to propose potential cost reductions and revenue enhancements
- Established new committee of the UF Board of Trustees to assist



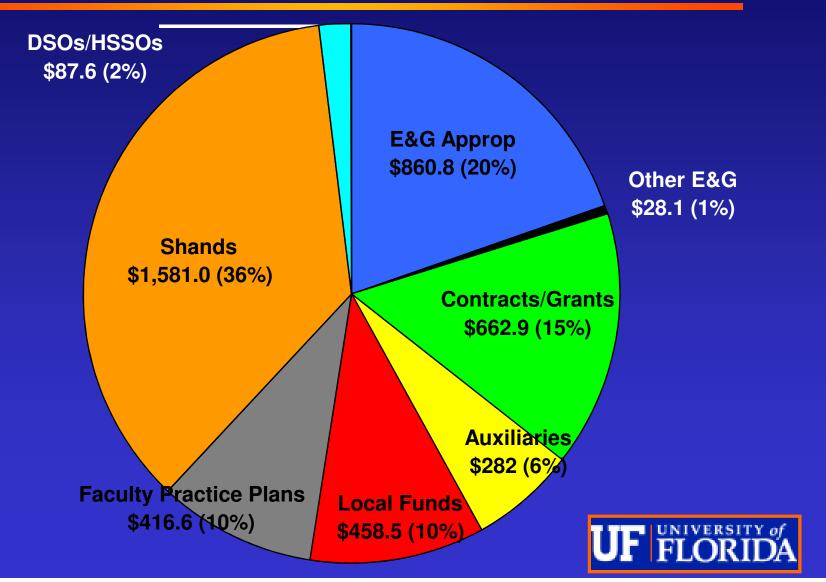
### Critical Situation: Impact on UF's Academic Programs

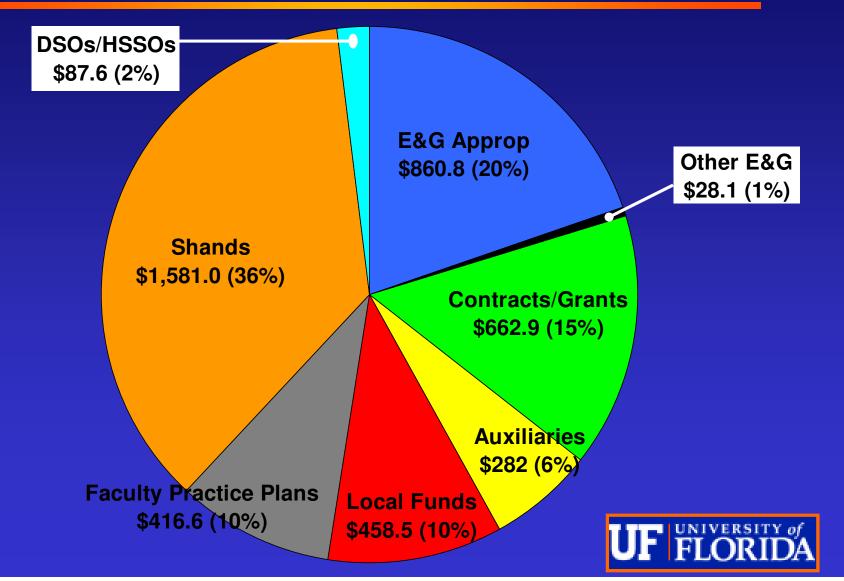
- At 17<sup>th</sup> among national public universities\*, and 49<sup>th</sup> overall\*, UF is the highest ranked Florida university
- Though 49<sup>th</sup> overall, UF's faculty resources rank is 123\*
- The faculty resources rank includes faculty salaries, student/faculty ratio, and class size
- The faculty resources rank has the most negative impact on UF's national rank and reflects a deteriorating undergraduate experience for students

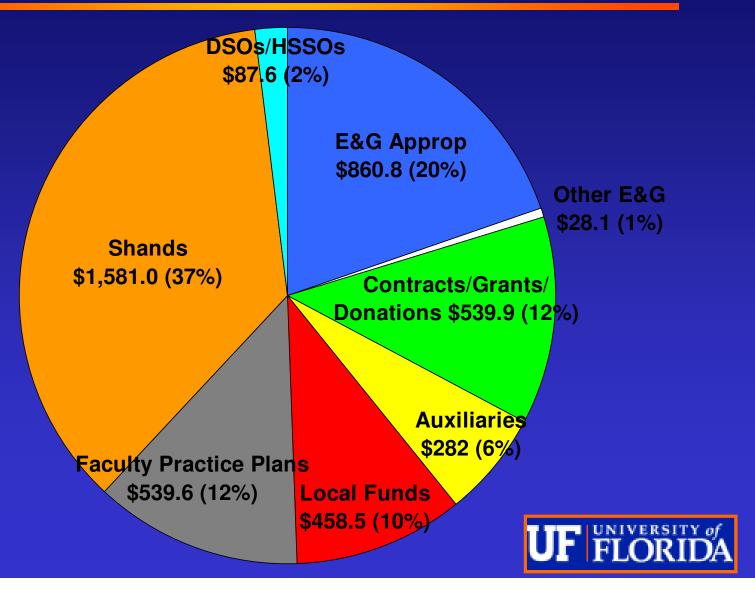
