Approval of Minutes from March 2010

Discussion with Wayne Griffin, Associate Director of the Counseling Center and Jen Day-Shaw, Dean of Students about how the Senate might assist in reviewing the current policies and procedures relevant to faculty/staff interaction with students who may be in crisis.

The council has been charged to discuss the faculty's rights and responsibilities regarding situations in which students, faculty or staff are acting in an unusual manner or a threatening manner.

The discussion will include some of the pertinent legal standards relevant to the higher education setting, including FERPA and student conduct concerns including standards related to psychological records and intervention including consultation, confidentiality and involuntary hospitalization criteria. The discussion may also include a review of the role and function of the Behavioral Consultation Team as a resource for faculty and staff in assisting students.
