Task Force Mission Statement:

- To inventory current resources and practices at UF
- To explore and catalogue the approaches taken at other institutions (both educational and industrial)
- To offer preliminary advice to Provost and Faculty Senate on directions UF can take that will make it a model for promoting a positive working environment for faculty.

Task Force Areas of Interest:

- Family-care and disability leaves (parental and pregnancy leave, family care leave, emergency care and other short-term leave, and longer-term leave for child rearing or other family responsibilities)
- Active service with modified duties
- Tenure clock (policy in process)
- Additional institutional support (child care centers or grants programs, elder and other family care, flexible work policies and schedules, concierge services, etc.)
- Partner accommodation policies (including anti-discrimination policies, hiring, benefits, etc.)
