Tom Walsh reported that this fall that the Federal Demonstration Partnership (FDP) Faculty Subcommittee on Administrative Burden will administer a web-based survey to explore the impact of recent changes in federal regulations on the time faculty spend pursuing active research. Results of the survey will be used to make recommendations to the Office of Management and Budget (OMB) for streamlining research administrative burden without reducing research accountability and regulation compliance. Mr. Walsh wanted the Council's opinion about participation of UF research faculty in this survey.

Action: It was decided that involvement in such a survey will be helpful and we should encourage our faculty to do so.

Mr. Walsh also talked about the NIH's "Request for Information on the Plan to Recognize Multiple Principal Investigators." It was indicated that all members of the faculty with NIH grants have received this notice from the NIH. The council thinks that this is a good idea.
